

Shelley von Strunckel



Witty, articulate and insightful, Shelley Von Strunckel is regarded as the voice of reason in the often-confusing field of astrology. Her knowledge and mastered practise of philosophy, spirituality and psychology are anchored by a background in marketing and retail and she is acknowledged by institutions, corporations and media outlets worldwide as a uniquely influential voice. .

Currently published in print and online across Europe, America, Australia and the Middle East, Shelley is familiar to millions across the globe for her intimate and accurate horoscope columns. She is also regarded as the world's foremost media astrologer, regularly hitting the airwaves with her resonant analysis of current trends, news and political personalities. As a guest-speaker across four continents, her topics extend beyond astrology to include

meditation, positive thinking and spiritual growth - focusing on turning these techniques into tools to improve daily life.

It is this intuitive fusion of skills, experience and communication expertise that brings the great and the good to her door – “looking not for prediction, but for understanding and guidance”, Shelley observes.

Born and raised in Hollywood, California, Shelley's career path started in fashion as a buyer. Her interest in philosophy and later, astrology, was there from her teens but was given a boost by an impressive chart reading for a lawyer handling a tricky case. When tragedy struck in 1975, with the deaths of her brother and boyfriend on the same day, her destiny was irreversibly shaped and soon after she became a full-time consultant astrologer.

She was discovered in 1991 by the late, highly regarded, Patric Walker, with whom she shared a byline in the Evening Standard. In 1992 she created the first ever astrological column in the Sunday Times and 16 years later she is still the most distinctive voice in astrology, with columns in the Sunday Times, Evening Standard, ES, Good Housekeeping, French and Chinese Vogue, Hong Kong's South China Morning Post, Gulf News (Dubai), and Hangbag.com, amongst many others. She has recently been commissioned by Tatler to write a regular column.

She is a frequent and popular guest on international radio and television. She regularly pops up on BBC Radio 2's Steve Wright Show and appearances have ranged from ABC and NBC in America, BBC, domestic and World Service, ITV and Channel 9 (Australia).

She currently has several television series in development and is planning to write a book.
